Association of Reflexologists (AoR)

The AoR was established in 1984 and is a not-for-profit organisation. Today it is the foremost independent professional association for reflexology in the UK. The letters MAR after a practitioner's name denotes their membership status, a sign of assurance that they have met the strictest standards of reflexology practice, are insured to practise and are committed to continually developing their skills and knowledge. All student members receive comprehensive indemnity and public liability insurance which covers them to complete their case studies whilst training and includes business equipment cover for up to £1000. Student membership is for 18 months and has many benefits including access to support materials in the dedicated Members Area on the AoR website.



Gateway Schools

The AoR recognise quality and have one of the highest eligibility criteria for membership in the industry. We are proud to be an AoR Gateway School, demonstrating that we have met the rigorous standards set by the AoR. This means that Temple graduates immediately qualify for AoR Membership. The Level 5 Diploma in Practitioner Reflexology is the highest level of attainment available in the UK. When delivered by an IRC Partner Centre, it is the only Level 5 Reflexology qualification endorsed by the Association of Reflexologists.

On Graduation

Upon successfully completing the course, graduates receive a nationally recognised qualification enabling them to gain insurance and practice as a reflexologist working with the general public. Graduates can also apply to register with the Complementary and Natural Healthcare Council (CNHC), which is the UK voluntary regulator for complementary therapy practitioners.

Course Structure

The Agored Cymru Level 5 Diploma in Practitioner Reflexology was revised in 2023 by the Integrated Reflexology Consortium Founder Partners in order to offer the latest cutting-edge information and techniques available to reflexologists. Our course



has been carefully designed to encourage creativity, confidence, competency, knowledge and professionalism; empowering graduates to develop successful reflexology businesses in the complementary health industry as it continues to evolve.

Ofqual assigns the Level 5 Diploma in Practitioner Reflexology units under the Skills for Health, Nursing, and Subjects Allied to Medicine sector. Each of the five units is reflexology-specific and has been designed, revised, and updated by experienced reflexologists in collaboration with Agored Cymru.

Level 5 is equivalent to a foundation degree or an HND in England and Wales. In contrast, a Level 3 qualification equates to an 'A' level standard. This qualification has been levelled at Level 5 for the reflexology units and Level 4 for the anatomy, physiology and pathophysiology for reflexology and business planning for reflexologists by the awarding body Agored Cymru.

The Agored Cymru Level 5 Diploma in Practitioner Reflexology consists of five mandatory units.



Reflexology Skills in Practice

This unit introduces your toolkit of hand and foot reflexology techniques and skills. We also cover clinical skills such as communication, ethics, and professionalism in detail. Theories on how reflexology works are discussed and analysed.

Providing Reflexology for Specific Conditions

In this unit, we examine the current research in reflexology and what comprises good research. We explore the use of reflexology in different stages of life, including its application in supporting babies, children and clients experiencing conditions related to the reproductive cycle, such as fertility, maternity, andropause, and menopause. We will also study the stress response, its far-reaching impacts on health, and how to use Adaptive Integrated Reflexology© AIR to support clients; including those in palliative care and with chronic ill health.

Incremental Development of Applied Reflexology Skills in Practice

This unit aims to enhance your skills and techniques in reflexology. You will deliver 100 treatments outside class hours, documenting them as comprehensive case studies with detailed rationale and analysis. The focus is on advancing your proficiency as a practitioner, introducing advanced techniques such as hand reflexology, energy techniques, "Inner Intent" reflexology, and more. Throughout this unit, there is an emphasis on the customisation of treatment plans for individual clients and specific conditions. For the course you will need a minimum of ten clients. You will carry out the100 treatments in your own home or the client's home. On average you will deliver two treatments a week.

Knowledge of Anatomy, Physiology and Pathology for Reflexology

Studied at level 4, we take a holistic and applied approach to understanding how our bodies are organised and how they work. We focus on stress and its physical and psychological effects on us. We consider how our body will naturally strive to bring itself back into balance and what we can do to encourage this. Assessment is mainly by workbooks and a few essays.

Business Skills for Reflexology Practice

In this module you will write a business plan, choose a name and logo, and draft leaflets and content for a website, as well as set up a cash flow forecast. We cover legal requirements for running your own business so that by the time the course is completed your new reflexology business can be up and running.

Commitment Required

The Agored Cymru Level 5 Diploma in Practitioner Reflexology requires a minimum of 160 face to face contact hours with your tutor. You will undertake approximately 15 hours per week of home study, including case study work and a couple of essays. Tutorials are usually scheduled via Zoom between class days.

This course has both academic and practical components. Due to its depth and the extensive workload required to complete portfolios of evidence, it may only be suitable for some. Please carefully consider how you will manage your time and integrate the course into your life.

To fully benefit from the learning opportunities provided, you must be organised, motivated, dedicated and have a robust support system.

Managing this course can be challenging for those with full-time employment and numerous family or social commitments.

This Level 5 course, equivalent to a foundation degree or Higher National Diploma (HND), requires research and referencing skills.

Entry Requirements

There is no requirement for any previous training or experience of complementary therapies.

- Age 18+ at enrolment
- You do not need to have any formal qualifications; however it is preferrable to have the
 equivalent of five GCSE passes at grade C or above and an adequate level of written
 and spoken English. A desire to learn and the motivation you need to progress and
 develop.
- Sufficient ability to perform reflexology techniques, we will discuss what is required at interview Sound experience of working with computers, downloading and uploading to a cloud
- Laptop (Chromebook and tablet devices are not suitable) with Microsoft Word, Dropbox, Zoom and Facebook accounts, and access to a printer.

Course Fee

We are currently enrolling for September 2024 and the cost of the course is £3,400. This includes a booking fee of £500 to secure your place. Please note there is an additional fee of £100 for learners enrolling at the Watford venue.

Payment Options

- Full course fee of £3400 paid in advance (this includes a £500 Booking Fee)
- £500 booking fee, then balance of £2900 prior to commencement of the course
- £500 booking fee, one payment of £260 and then 11 monthly payments of £240

NB. The RT Velio and R clip Batyline are not suitable. They do not support the client's back sufficiently and tend to bounce up and down during treatment.

There are two main types; standard stools and saddle stools - this is a personal choice. The stool must have good quality caster wheels and it is important that it is height adjustable up to a minimum of 65cm. NB must be a stool not a chair.
